This updated course is the entry-level Signs & Markings program. It is designed to insure all personnel have extensive exposure to basic procedures in the specialized field of signs and pavement markings. Level 1 will cover the fundamentals of, installation and maintenance of all signs and pavement markings. Michigan has now standardized on the MUTCD with a Michigan supplement and you are expected to bring a copy of the MUTCD as your second resource. The Signs & Markings, Lev.1 Specialist should, by nature of this certification title, master the basic principles behind signing and pavement marking. Although the individual who is approved to take the Level I exam may have a great deal of field experience, the exam will require that he be able to communicate this knowledge in a written format. The best way to prepare is to begin a review of the topics that will be covered on the exam. One year of experience is required for certification. If the individual has not had 1 year of experience, they may take the course and apply for the certification when the one year timeframe requirement has been reached.
