Mystery Creek offers great campsites on grass with water and electric hookup if needed and your reservation will guarantee your spot! The camping fee is nominal, camping sites are groomed and they can accommodate any type of vehicle/tent.

Although 'verbal' commitments are made, it is now time to fax your reservation. We have plenty of camping sites and also want to insure you get the watercraft(s) of your choice. Kayaks, canoes, floats (etc) have been reserved for our outing but your reservation (sate) will insure you get the craft(s) of your choice. Don't delay! Mark your calendar and send your reservation now.

For those who have a problem sleeping in a cozy tent, you can call the Oak Ridge Motel (231 652-1288) which is ~ 8 miles from the campground. This is a busy time of year for this motel and reservations should be made now.

- Mystery Creek Campground, ~30 miles north of GR. (Ph) 231 834-7505.
- Campground amenities offer: Children's playground; general store for small items, horseshoe, shuffleboard, horseshoe, volleyball and laundry.
- The group river trip begins Saturday morning (10AM) from this campground and return transportation is included.
- Watercraft: Canoes, kayaks, lounge chairs, tubes and six person rafts are reserved with your reservation.
- Carrier & Gable (once again) has generously offered to pay for your watercraft!
- Thursday arrivals are possible. Please contact Tim (586 929-3309) if you would like to do so.

The Muskegon River is wide, slow moving and generally pretty shallow in this area, providing a very relaxing and fun filled float and don't forget to bring your 'energy drinks' of choice! One more option for those of you with your own craft, is to bring it with you - as long as it's not motorized. Transport back to camp is included.

One last option is available for those who would like to participate in the canoe trip without camping is to show up by 9AM on Saturday. You might even be able to 'scarf' up a little leftover breakfast from those *serious* campers and get ready for fun!

Evening campfires rule the night. Bring your chairs, beverages and prepare to hear some tall stories!
