Mystery Creek is a very nice facility offering great campsites with water and electric hookup if needed. Camping fee is nominal and historically, Carrier & Gable has graciously offered to pay for watercraft rental. Grass campsites can accommodate any size vehicle/tent.

You will need to contact the campground directly for reservations under a block of sites reserved for IMSA. Don't delay as these sites will be open to the public May 1, 2017. Reservations for watercraft should be sent directly to Tim DeWitt by fax or email (see below). Watercraft selections will be based upon the date your reservation is received. Don't delay! Fax or email your watercraft reservation today.

For those who have a problem sleeping in a cozy tent, there are a number of close economical lodging opportunities available in the area. This is a busy time of year for lodging and you are encouraged to make room reservations soon.

- The group river trip begins Saturday morning (11AM) from our campground with return transportation.
- Watercraft available: Canoes, kayaks, lounge chairs, tubes and four & six person rafts.
- Wood can be purchased at the campground or you can bring your own.

The Muskegon River is wide, slow moving and generally pretty shallow in this area. It provides a very relaxing and fun filled float, especially if you bring your beverage of choice! One more option for those of you with your own craft, is to bring it with you - as long as it's not motorized. Transport back to camp will be provided.

One last option for those who would like to participate in the Saturday canoe trip *without* camping is to show up by 10AM. You might even be able to 'scarf' up a little leftover breakfast from the *serious* campers.
