Details

- Reservations must be made by calling Chinook campground directly at 231 834-7505.
- Chinook Campground, 5471 W. 112th St., Grant, MI. (~30 miles north of GR.)
- The IMSA group river trip starts with a bus ride to our kick-off point Saturday morning. We will be picked up at 11:00AM sharp and will finish the float trip (3-4 hours) back at our campground.
- Watercraft available: Canoes, kayaks, lounge chairs, tubes (Single/Double) and rafts 2 people +coolers (each).
- Wood can be purchased at the campground or you can bring your own.
- Thursday arrivals are possible. Please contact Tim at 586 929-3309 to discuss before calling the campground.

The Muskegon River is wide, slow moving and generally pretty shallow in this area. It provides a very relaxing and fun filled float, especially if you bring along your beverage of choice!

For those who would like to participate in the Saturday canoe trip *without* camping, you *must* show up prior to the bus leaving at 10:45 AM sharp. You might even be able to 'scarf' up a little leftover breakfast from the serious campers if you get there early enough.

Evening campfires rule the night. Bring your chairs, beverages and prepare to hear tall stories unfold!
